The philosophy of the Independent Technical Review (ITR) is to: 1) ensure the technical analyses meet appropriate standards; 2) ensure compliance with applicable laws and statutes, as well as Corps of Engineers policy; 3) resolve issues prior to the release of the report to the public, customer, and Corps higher authority; 4) be a continual process commensurate with the scope and complexity of the analyses; and 5) the ITR be documented.


In accordance with the District's Quality Control Plan, critical technical components of the formulation and evaluation of the alternatives leading to the identification of the recommended plan were undertaken. The most critical components included the hydrologic and hydraulic modeling, flood damage estimates, and the estimation of quantities and cost estimates. The study was completed in its entirety by in-house labor from the Fort Worth District. Independent technical reviews were also completed with in-house staff.



The District was given permission to release the report to the public without further review by Southwestern Division, Corps of Engineers.


**CERTIFICATION OF TECHNICAL, POLICY, AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY**
