Thank you for your correspondence describing the above referenced project. This letter serves as comment on the proposed undertaking from the State Historic Preservation Officer, the Executive Director of the Texas Historical Commission.

The review staff, led by Bradford Patterson, has reviewed the information received on October 30, 2007. We concur with the Corps of Engineer's determination that the undertaking will have an adverse effect on some of the historic resources within the area of potential effect. We also believe that the project will potentially have an adverse effect on the former North Main Power Plant. We look forward to meeting with your office and the other consulting parties in early January to discuss possible methods to minimize or mitigate the adverse effects on historic resources.

We look forward to further consultation with your office, and hope to maintain a partnership that will foster effective historic preservation.
