The public is hereby notified of the availability of the Draft Supplemental Environmental Assessment (EA) and Draft Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the proposed mitigation plan modifications to the original detailed project report and EA completed in 2002. The approved project was initiated under the authority of Section 205 of the Flood Control Act of 1948, as amended to evaluate potential solutions to flooding problems associated with Little Fossil Creek in Haltom City. Based upon modifications required during advanced project design, it was determined that a supplemental environmental assessment was needed.

This Supplemental EA identifies and evaluates new mitigation alternatives, and it assesses the direct, indirect, and cumulative impacts from these proposed actions on the human and natural environment.
