Corps of Engineers, Waco Lake announce Midway Park Boat Ramp Restoration project

FORT WORTH, Texas -- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Waco Lake announced that Midway Park Boat Ramp will be temporarily closed for three weeks to restore the flood-damaged parking area, beginning Monday, April 20, 2009.

Waco Lake has several other boat ramps and park areas available to the public. The nearest ramp to Midway Park is located at Twin Bridges Day Use Area. Other Day Use Areas with boat ramps include Airport Beach, Koehne Park, and Flat Rock Access Area. Lacy Point Access Area boat ramp remains open, with access to 20 miles of free multiple use trails for hiking, biking, and horse back riding.

All Waco Lake campgrounds are open and offer boat ramp access, including Airport Park, Reynolds Creek Park, Speegleville Park. Campers can reserve a campsite by calling toll-free 1-877-444-6777 or by visiting www.recreation.gov.

The Waco Lake staff encourages all visitors to play it safe while in and around the water by wearing your life jacket, staying on marked trails and obeying all posted signs. For additional information, please contact the Waco Lake Office at 254-756-5359.
