## **Corps of Engineers and Partners to Enhance Waco Lake Aquatic Environment**

: 30 SECOND PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

PLEASE AIR BEGINNING May 10, 2009 THROUGH May 26, 2009

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Waco Lake, along with representatives from the City of Waco, and Texas Parks and Wildlife Inland Fisheries are partnering to enhance Waco Lake's aquatic environment. On May 12, the Corps, City of Waco, Parks and Wildlife, and volunteer groups will begin adding native aquatic plants, vegetation, and hybrid Striped White Bass in Waco Lake to augment aquatic habitat. This habitat improvement effort will last about three weeks and will be focused around Woodway, Speegleville and Reynolds Creeks.
