Corps of Engineers at Waco Lake provide facility update for Memorial Day weekend

FORT WORTH, Texas -- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Waco Lake announced today that road repairs at Midway Park have been completed ahead of schedule and the boat ramp is open in time for the Memorial Day weekend.

The primary Airport Beach restroom and shower facility that was destroyed in the 2007 flood, has undergone complete restoration and is also be open for the holiday weekend.

Visitors to the Twin Bridges Day Use Area may notice temporary closures of selected picnic areas beginning May 28. The picnic shelters were damaged during the 2007 flood and are being repaired. This will cause temporary closures of selected areas as shelters are repaired but the park will remain open to the public throughout these repairs.
