Corps of Engineers at Sam Rayburn Lake close boat ramp, parking area at Hanks Creek for maintenance

FORT WORTH, Texas -- The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Sam Rayburn Lake announced today that Hanks Creek Park Day Use area boat ramp and parking areas will temporarily close to all vehicles for routine maintenance.

The closure, weather permitting, will allow the Corps to stripe the boat ramp and parking areas to designate parking spaces and improve parking and traffic flow. The boat ramp will close at 9 p.m. Wednesday, June 3 and reopen to the public Thursday, June 4 at 9 p.m. The swim beach parking area will open to the public Saturday, June 6 at 8 a.m.
