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## **Sam Rayburn Lake flood gate maintenance in August requires temporary closure of RR255**

*FORT WORTH, Texas* – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Sam Rayburn Lake will close Rural Route 255 on different nights over the next several months in order to perform routine maintenance, removal and replacement on the flood gates. The highway will be closed between the Twin Dikes Public Boat Ramp and the entrance of Ebenezer Park with the next closures scheduled for August 2 and 4 starting at 10 p.m. and lasting for approximately seven hours each. The best alternate route will be through Jasper using Highways 63 and US 96.
