## **Corps of Engineers announces Granger Lake's Wilson H. Fox Park closure due to construction**

*FORT WORTH, TEXAS*— The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District announces the closure of Wilson H. Fox Park at Granger Lake for public safety measures due to construction of a raw water intake structure and pump station and a 48" pipeline by the Brazos River Authority.

Wilson H. Fox Park will close September 12 and is scheduled to reopen prior to the 2012 Memorial Day Weekend. The intake will furnish a dependable supply of water to serve the East Williamson County Regional Water System water treatment plant on the south side of Granger Lake.
