## U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announce road closure at Sam Rayburn Lake

*FORT WORTH, Texas* – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Sam Rayburn Lake announce the closure of Recreation Road 255 across the top of the Power Plant and the entire Dam Section. Closure of RR255 will allow replacement of old bridge crane trolleys under an American Recovery and Revitalization Act Contract on October 26 at 3 a.m. to October 27 at approximately 9 a.m. The road closure will be from Ebenezer Park road to the Umphreys Pavilion section with access remaining open on either side of the Dam.

A potential alternate route to avoid any delays during the approximate 30 hour closure will be through Jasper using Highways 63 and US 96. For more information please contact Scott Lynn or Tom Webb at the Sam Rayburn Power Plant at (409) 384-5292.
