


Abilene, Texas (Water Supply)

Purpose: Water resource problems and opportunities are currently identified for ecosystem restoration, water supply and water quality. WRDA 2007 authorized feasibility studies for Abilene Water Supply. The 2007 Texas State Water plan identified the Cedar Ridge reservoir site, about 50 miles north of the city of Abilene, as a possible alternative to partially resolve the projected shortage of water supply in the region.
