



Dallas Floodway Extension, Texas

Purpose: The project consists of a Chain of Wetlands(1.5 miles upper; 2.2 miles lower), two SPF levees (Lamar Street – 2.9 miles and Cadillac Heights – 2.3 miles), 123 acres of wetlands for ecosystem restoration, realignment of the Trinity River at IH-45, 31 miles of linear recreations, and 1,179 acres of mitigation.
