LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The city of Arlington is located in north central Texas, approximately 16 miles east of Fort Worth. The potential restoration area is located along North Cottonwood Creek, within the city limits of Arlington, in Tarrant County. Cottonwood Creek is a tributary of the Trinity River. The creek runs in a northeasterly direction for approximately 900 linear feet and is bound by Sherry Street to the west and Greenway Street to the east.

PROPOSED ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2008: No funds were allocated for this project in FY 2008.

APPLICATION OF THE AMOUNT THAT COULD BE USED IN FY 2009: FY 2009 funds could be used to develop the Project Management Plan, execute the Feasibility Cost Share Agreement, and fully fund the feasibility phase of this project.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION: Implementation of the Preliminary Restoration Plan (PRP) would restore and sustain approximately 4.5 acres of aquatic ecosystem and associated riparian grass/woodland habitat within North Cottonwood Creek. The PRP would also incidentally restore native riparian corridor vegetation and wildlife habitat, improve water quality, and reduce downstream sediment loads. The non-Federal sponsor is the city of Arlington.
