




Guadalupe and San Antonio Rivers Basins, Texas

Purpose: There are three active Interim Feasibilities Studies under the Guadalupe and San Antonio River Basins (GSAR) study authority - Leon, Cibolo and Salado Creeks. This study is investigating the water resource problems, needs and opportunities of the Guadalupe and San Antonio River Basins to determine flood risk management alternatives, especially as it applies to human safety, and other allied purposes that include ecosystem restoration, water quality, water supply and recreation. Both structural and non-structural alternatives have been identified and are currently being evaluated.
