



Lewisville Dam, Texas (Dam Seepage Control)

Purpose: USACE identified dam safety issues and concerns at Lewisville Dam, Texas, during the project's Screening for Portfolio risk Assessment. The assessment resulted in Lewisville Dam receiving a Dam Safety Action Classification (DSAC) II rating. DSAC II dams are considered unsafe or potentially unsafe and require immediate action/attention. An Interim Risk Reduction Measures Plan (IRRMP) has been drafted and an Issues Evaluation Study (IES) initiated Fiscal Year 2009. A Dam Safety Modification Study (DSMS) will be initiated in Fiscal Year 2010, if deemed necessary.
