Notice: Planting for Mitigation Webpage

We have added a new webpage to our Regulatory website,
<http://www.swf.usace.army.mil/regulatory>.

Planting for Mitigation is intended to provide information that may improve the success and quality of mitigation planting projects. Information from the Checklist of the Vascular Plants of Texas (Hatch, *et al.* 1990) was used to determine plant species distribution within Texas. The US Fish and Wildlife Services' National List of Plant Species That Occur in Wetlands: South Plains (Region 6) (Reed, P.B., Jr. 1988 U.S. Fish Wildl. Serv. Biol. Rep. 88(26.9) was used to provide an indicator status of the water regime in which the wetland plants in Texas are usually found. Information about the plant species as sources of valuable wildlife forage was also included. The new webpage contains lists of species, either trees or herbaceous, for each of the 10 Ecoregions in Texas.
