



Johnson Creek, Upper Trinity Basin, Arlington, Texas

Purpose: The new authorized project includes the components of the project authorized in 1999 (a buy-out of 140 structures for flood risk management, 155 acres of ecosystem restoration, and 2.25 miles of hard surface trail, picnic facilities and a pavilion), in addition to construction of new bank stabilization, additional flood risk management, recreation, and habitat restoration measures along Johnson Creek.
