



Sulphur River Basin, Texas

Purpose: An accumulation of sediment and debris has severely restricted the Sulphur River channel, adversely impacting levees, cropland, bridges, and ecological resources. Preliminary investigations identified opportunities for flood risk management; ecosystem restoration; water supply, including reallocation at Wright Patman Lake, systems operations optimizations between Jim Chapman and Wright Patman Lakes and potential construction of new multi-purpose reservoirs; and development of a comprehensive watershed management plan.
